- redirecting bad requests without errors 4xx, 5xx that can make your site more attractive for search engines;
 - logging bad requests to a database that can help you to know about hacking attempts against you site;
 - converting non-SEF URLs to SEF;
 - redirecting non error requests that let you implicitly close access to some sections of your site;
 - fully automatic functioning that let your site after simple initial configuration manage bad requests without further manual work.

How to use Redirects Component

After you successfully installed Redirects Component for Joomla!1.5 you have to configure it first! To do it you should create your custom error page (just create a new article for that). After that add a new menu item to that page (you can unpublish it or add it to a menu that is never displayed on your site). See [Joomla! Documentation](#) for more information about custom error pages in Joomla! Then go directly to Redirects Component, open Parameters window and choose the menu item you've just created in the Redirect URL dropdown list. That's it! Since now all the incorrect requests to your site handled by Joomla! will be redirected automatically!
